


Annual Meeting & Returning Mail Ballots

TV Rate Increases

As was announced in the February newsletter, the annual WCDTV cost increase will range from \$6-\$10, to cover the rising cost of programming.

Effective March 1st, 2025, TV rates will be:

Retransmission + TV Package = Total TV Cost

Lite: \$37.84 + \$15.11 = **\$52.95** *increase of \$6 from previous rate

Standard: \$37.84 + \$86.11 = \$123.95 *increase of \$10 from previous rate **Ultimate:** \$37.84 + \$106.11 = \$143.95 *increase of \$10 from previous rate *Retransmission fees and the TV package price are separate line items on your monthly invoice.*
